Adults are carefully selected to teach and mentor our students in God's Word. Our staff of volunteer teachers puts in many hours preparing lessons that reinforce God's plan for them through Bible teachings. The curriculum is designed for hands-on and active learning in each classroom to reinforce these Bible truths. Out of classroom activities are scheduled to encourage children to develop friendships, a heart for serving, and leadership training.

Infants and Cradle Roll

Nursery care is provided during our scheduled Bible classes and worship assemblies.

Our nursery facility is staffed by paid and trained workers. Nursery workers take special care to insure a clean and safe environment for all children. An in-house paging system keeps parents just a page away from their children if needed during nursery or cradle roll times.

Our Cradle Roll teaching center is located in our nursery facility. A group of teachers works with these children as they teach Bible stories through repetition using many visuals, puppets, songs and other hands-on learning aids.

Preschool

Our preschool teachers continue to build and expand the Bible learning process through interactive classes. The classes are designed to help preschoolers enhance their knowledge of God's love for them.

Elementary

Throughout the elementary years we continue to maximize our children's learning experiences through innovative Sunday morning and Wednesday night classes. Our Wednesday night program is designed to build on the application of our students' growing Bible knowledge. The Discover class is a self-paced Bible learning experience designed especially for our fifth grade students.



SONshine Worship

K-2nd Graders attend the morning worship assembly until such time as they are dismissed to SONshine Worship, which lasts through the duration of the morning assembly. SONshine Worship is designed to help students learn more of God's Word and the principles of worship. SONshine Worship is offered during the school year only.

Childcare

Nursery, Toddlers, and 2-Year-Olds receive in-class childcare on Sunday mornings immediately after Bible class through the duration of the morning worship assembly.

Bible Hour

Three and four-year-old students who are signed up for Bible Hour are taken directly from Bible class to the Bible Hour room at the second dismissal bell. Bible Hour lasts through the duration of the morning worship assembly. Bible Hour is offered year-round in room 20.

Mac Pac

Mac Pac is our 3rd-5th grade group. Monthly throughout the school year we will have special Mac Pac activities. These activities are family involved and a parent must attend with their Mac Pac student. Mac Pac activities are family led and involved.

Summer Camp

Camp Impact is located on the campus of Oklahoma Christian University in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Our preteen group travels by bus to Camp Impact for a dynamic camp experience full of Bible classes, worship, games, fellowship, and more. Camp Impact is scheduled for the last Sunday of June through Thursday of that week.
